



School Day Tours Excursion Management Information

Tours must be paid for on or prior to the day of the tour.

As the program is run by volunteers, we need a choice of two dates for the visit so that we can make sure that we have enough people for one of the dates.

All our volunteers have Working With Children cards.

Unless requested earlier, our Emergency Evacuation Plan and the Certificate of Currency will be sent with our date confirmation
Please ensure you have a list of students and helpers attending in case of an emergency.

For Year 3 – 6 students, there must be one adult for every ten students. Any adults over this number may be charged at the adult rate for Day Tours. Education Assistants who are needed to attend to specific students are not included in the adult/student ratio.

The teacher in charge of the supervisory team is responsible for the supervision of and any specific requirements of the students at all times.

Perth Observatory has basic First Aid kits. If you have students who have allergies and/or require specific medication please bring it with you. Perth Observatory volunteers are not allowed to give medication to students.

The students will work in small groups with a volunteer running the session. Please put the students into the number of groups requested by the observatory prior to the visit.

Please let us know if you have students with disabilities. Activities may be outside and there is walking involved and some domes have stairs. We do have wheelchairs available if needed. Wheelchair access to the main building is via a ramp at the back.

In the event of an emergency there will be three sets of three blasts of a siren sounded and the presenter will direct the group s/he is working with to the muster point.

Note: No smoking is permitted on the grounds of the Perth Observatory
